As we discussed yesterday, the rationale for postponing this event is tied to security issues and the lack of a risk management plan. With our knowledge of potential protesters and the advertising of your event on the weneedaLaw website, we feel the potential for conflict is high. That being said, with additional planning and the involvement of our risk management team, there is every possibility for this event to have success at a later date.

Ultimately, UFV's mandate is to have an event that is civil and safe for our University community. To achieve this goal your planning committee should work with institutional partners and have a desire to create an event that provides a balanced view of the issue at hand. I know from our meeting yesterday that you are both passionate about this issue and are truly interested in creating dialogue and awareness.

I know you will be disappointed with this news and I hope we can work together to make your event a success.
